The new membership fee schedule is as follows:

#### **Family Child Care Members (LNR and Licensed Family Child Care Provider)**

- Annual membership Fee for 2010/2011 - **\$1.00 (KCCS Membership fee)**

#### **Parent and General Public Members**

- Annual membership Fee for 2010/2011 - **\$25.00 (includes \$1.00 KCCS Membership fee)**

#### **Individual Licensed Group Child Care Programs**

- **(1 – 3 staff) - Annual membership Fee for 2010/2011 - \$25.00 (includes \$1.00 KCCS Membership fee). This membership will allow a maximum of any 3 staff to attend any workshop or course provided by the CCRR Program.**

**Note:** Membership is specific to the licensed child care program not the agency. An agency or multi service organization may have several licensed child care programs under their umbrella. Each licensed child care program is required to have their own membership in order to access membership services specifically for their program. Individual staff can still purchase their own KCCS CCRR membership.
